The next forums are scheduled for Sudbury and Northwestern Ontario. The comments and questions/discussions have been constructive. The MNO continues to participate in the "Learn More Process" and also has developed a formal and comprehensive Mining Trade certification Program. Interest was expressed by the President of the Greenstone Métis Council on the progress/status of the Hornepayne "Learn More Process..

Discussions with the Northeast Superior Regional Chiefs Forum are engaged for the next meeting. It was noted that a representative of the Hornepayne First Nation participated in the "Learn More Tour" as a member of the Hornepayne CLC. .

.A new Funding Program to support Aboriginal Engagement for First Nation communities and regional organizations and the Metis to Learn More is now available and ready to accept proposals for 2013. A meeting was held with Noah Mederios, Band Manager, Hornepayne First Nation, on a project update and to discuss the criteria/submission requirements of the new funding program to assist the HFN in preparing their Proposal.

Contact would be made with the Ontario Provincial Police Special Constable Program unit regarding their presentation of the of an Aboriginal Cultural Awareness session the Hornepayne CLC as previously requested.
