6.1. A. Update on NWMO activity

Currently there are twenty communities in step three of the Learn More Process. Central Huron is the only community in step two and will be making their decision shortly whether to move into step three.

Recently, Nipigon had their first Step Three open house- Mixed reaction from the community.

A meeting was held, June 10th with senior NWMO staff and the Mayor or a delegate from each of the eight communities that have been engaged in the Learn more process for the longest. Mayor Morley Forster was in attendance, representing Hornepayne.

It was announced that by this fall – end of the year 2013, the eight communities would be narrowed down to a few potential communities that will enter, phase two of stage three.

In phase two of stage three, there will be increased regional engagement and more extensive geoscientific analysis of the potential host communities.
