**6. Old Business**

- a) NOMA Spring Conference Committee Members updates  
Councillor Fraser noted that the transportation exhibit was very interesting. Members Herman Dost and Greg Gothard agreed and further spoke of how well attended it was.  
Member Penny Lucas reported that the comments made after one of the NWMO exhibits from the public were very positive and people were more comfortable and less hesitant to ask questions. Communication Update

Pat Dolcetti spoke of the positive reception with the transportation exhibit. The Committee plan to distribute the next newsletter in June after the final draft is approved by the Committee. The next edition of "Ask the NWMO" will be in the Ignace Driftwood next week. Nipigon has moved into Step 3 of the selection process.

Ray Hatfield reported on Project Information presentations with the Metis Nation of Ontario Regional Consultation Committees held in: Sault Ste. Marie, Timmins, Terrace Bay and Sudbury. A fifth forum is planned for Northwestern Ontario with a meeting date to be determined. The Metis Nation of Ontario already have Mining Training Program with a focus to develop a qualified mining workforce from within the Metis Community.

A copy of a Letter to Editor by Jon McDonald, President of the Jackfish Metis Association near Schreiber, published in the Thunder Bay Chronicle Journal was provided to the CLC. Wabigoon Lake Ojibway Nation has been approved for a Learn More Tour of a current storage facility which is scheduled for Thurs. June 27<sup>th</sup>. Science North visited the Wabigoon Lake Ojibway Nation School on May 13, 2013 and the reaction from the students was very positive. An information brochure was also provided describing a new funding program to assist First Nations to Learn More about the Project.

Community Profile
